What is the Judiciary Opportunities for Building Success Program?

The New Jersey Judiciary's Opportunities for Building Success Program (JOBS) connects private companies and non-profit organizations with successful recovery court, probation, and child support clients who want to rebuild their lives and want to work.

The JOBS program presents an exceptional opportunity to strengthen the collaboration between government and the business community, while giving you a chance to reclaim your life.

Who is eligible for the program?

To qualify for the employment program, you must be under active probation supervision in recovery court, Intensive Supervision Program, child support, or general community supervision.

You must cooperate with probation supervision, satisfy child support obligations, and recovery court clients are routinely scheduled to see the recovery court judge.

What you can receive?

Access to exclusive job fairs, job readiness training, and opportunities to participate in professional certification programs.
