Traffic: Includes all traffic charges except for D.W.I charges and parking charges.

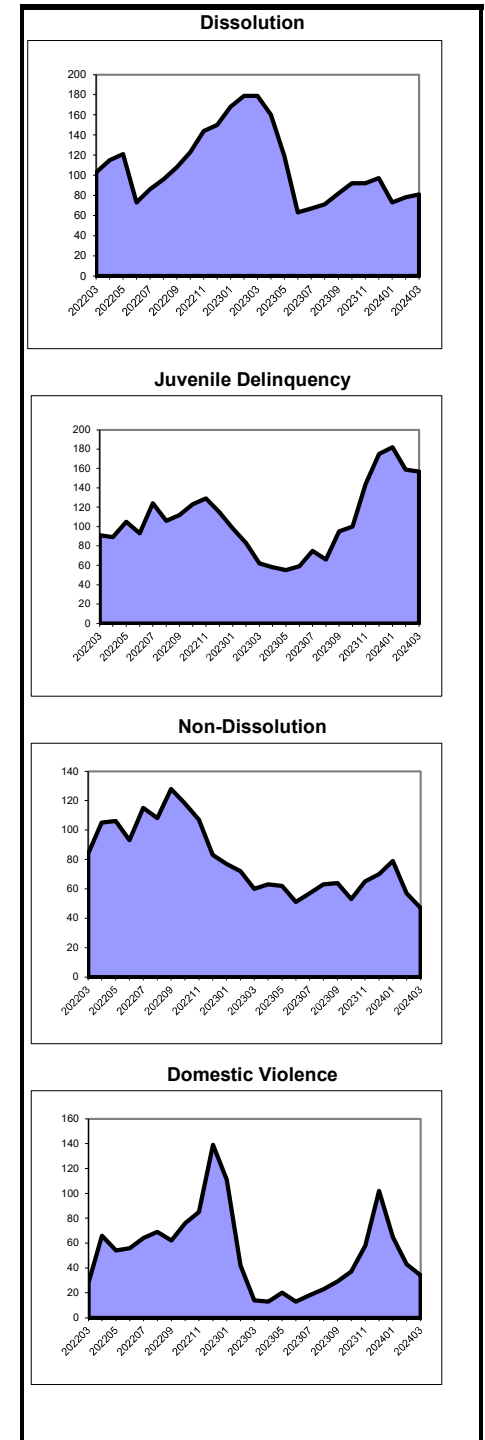

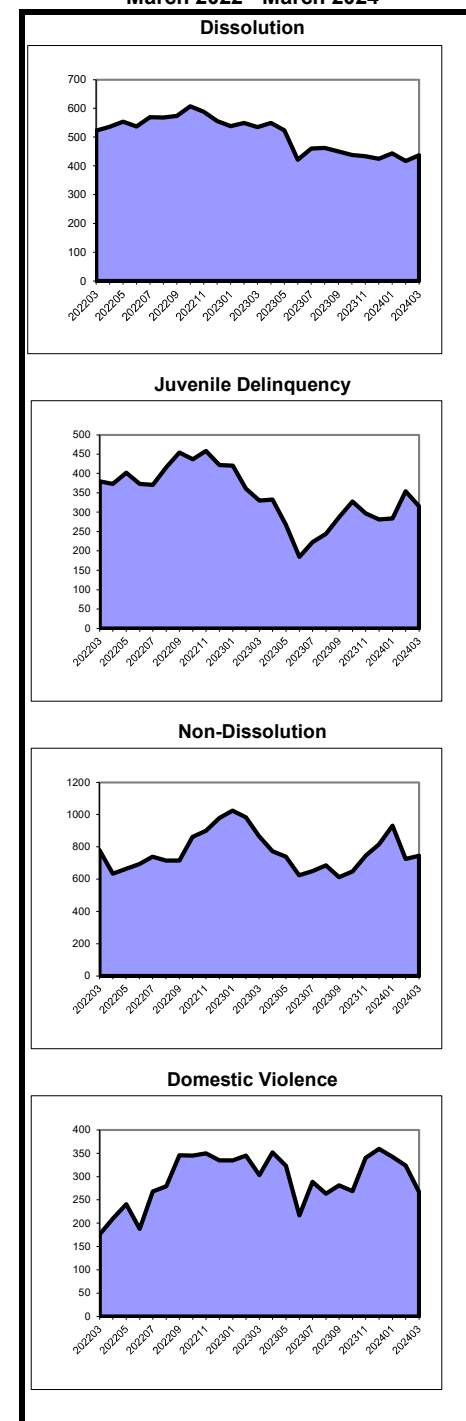

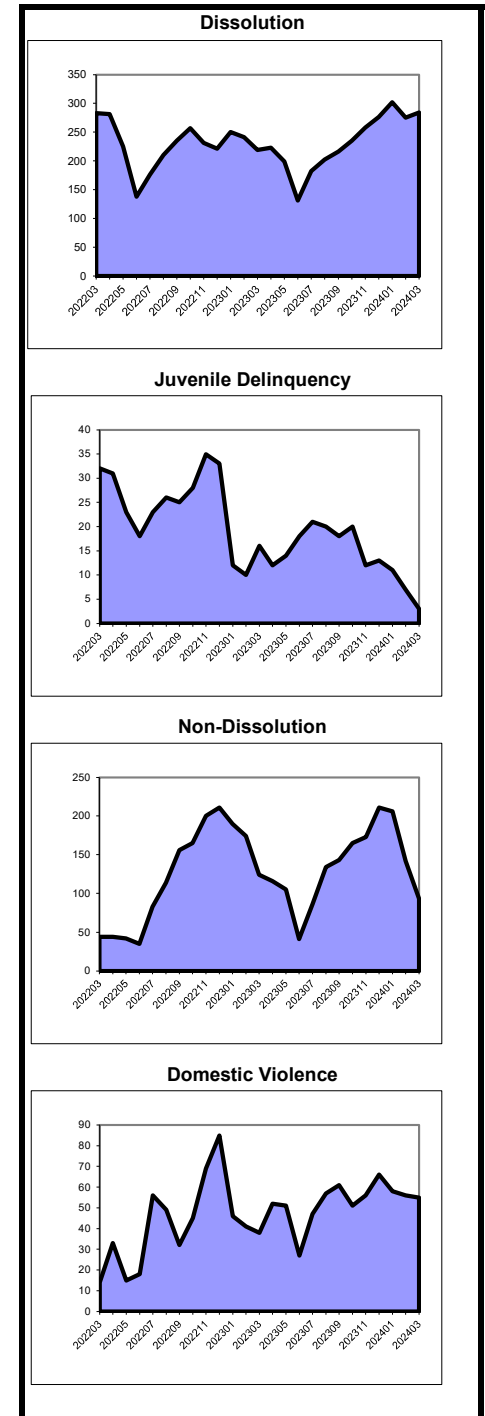

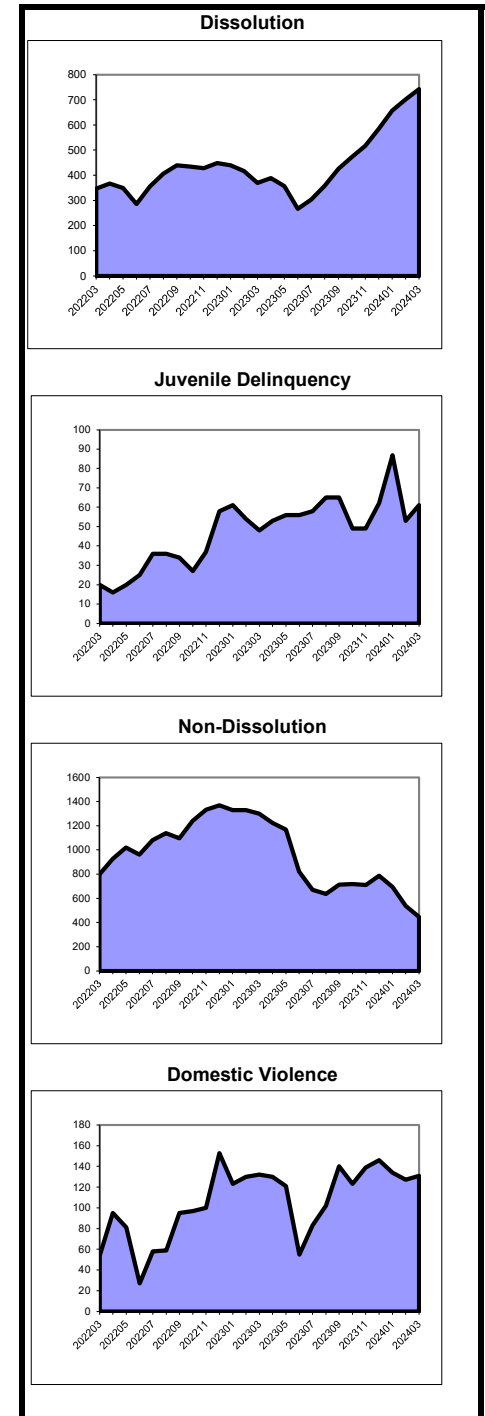
**Backlog By Month

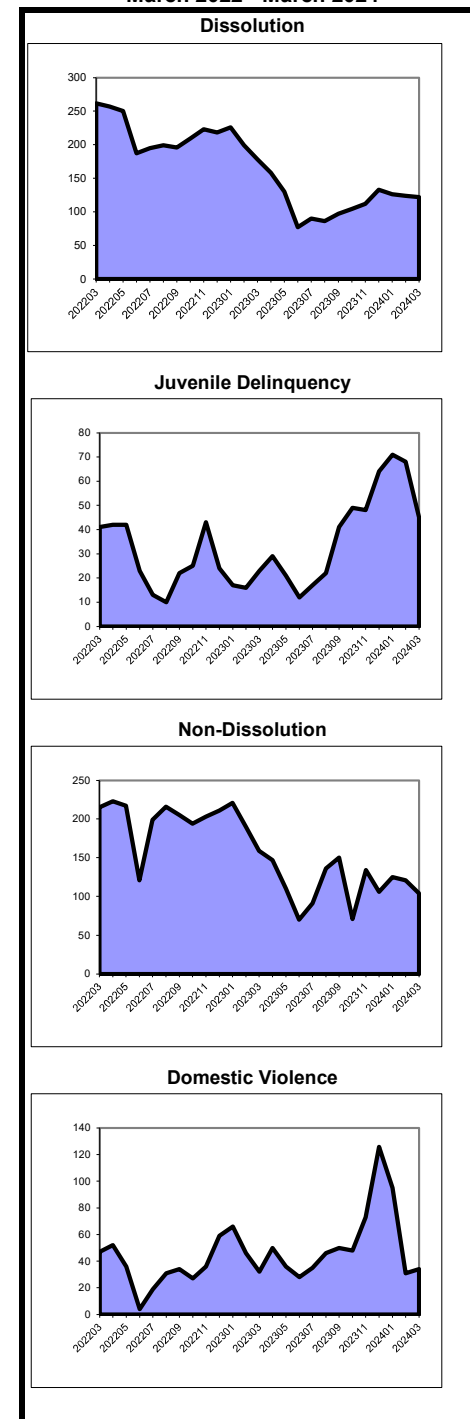

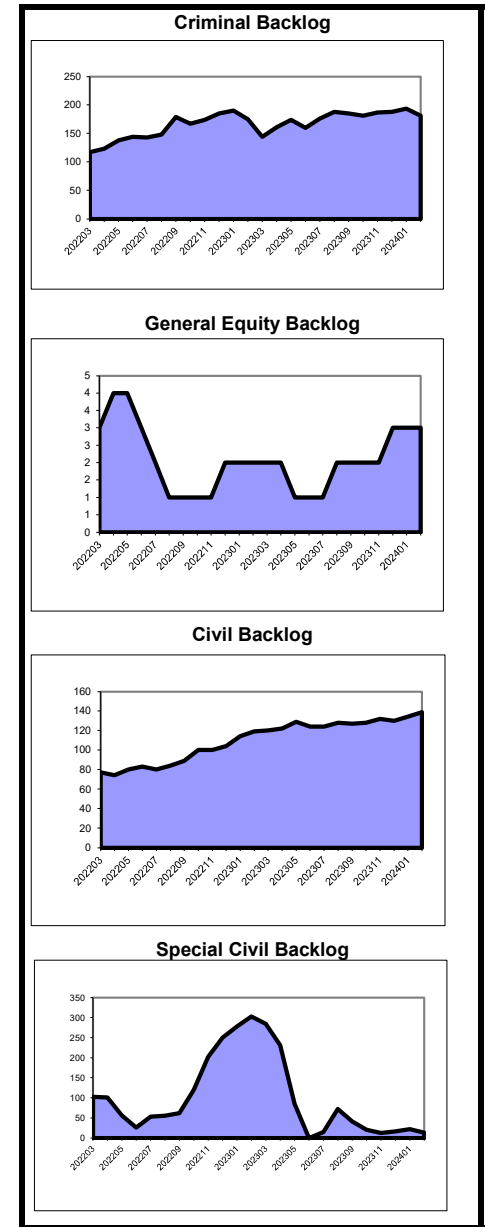

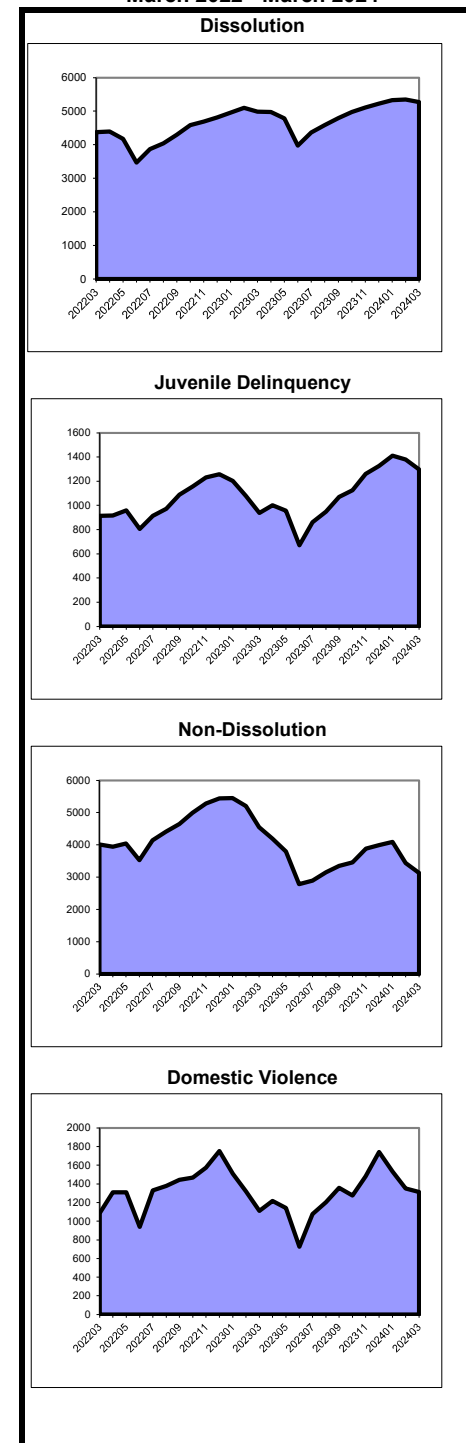

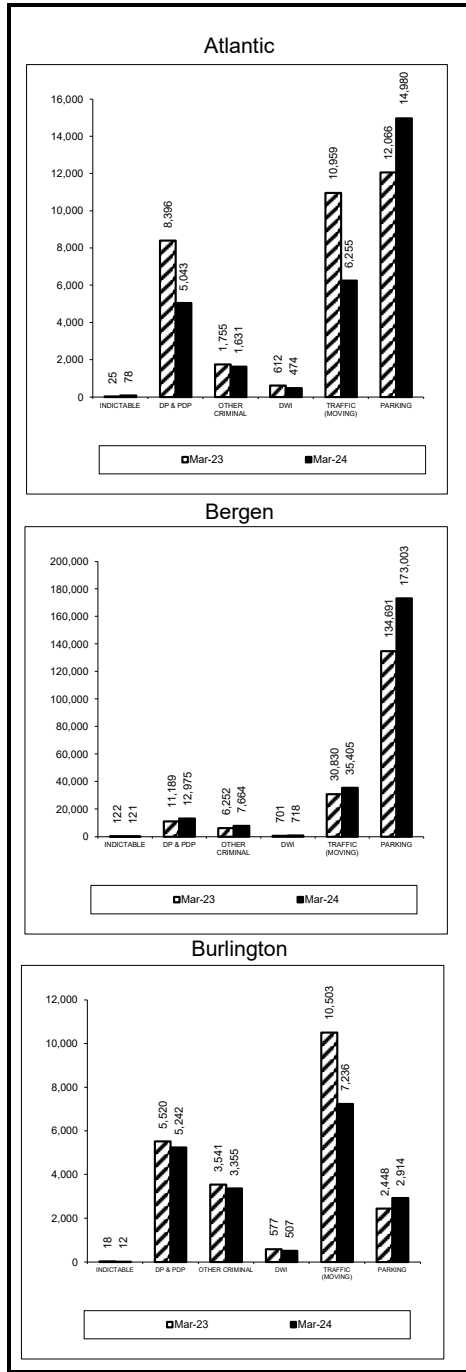

March 2022 - March 2024**

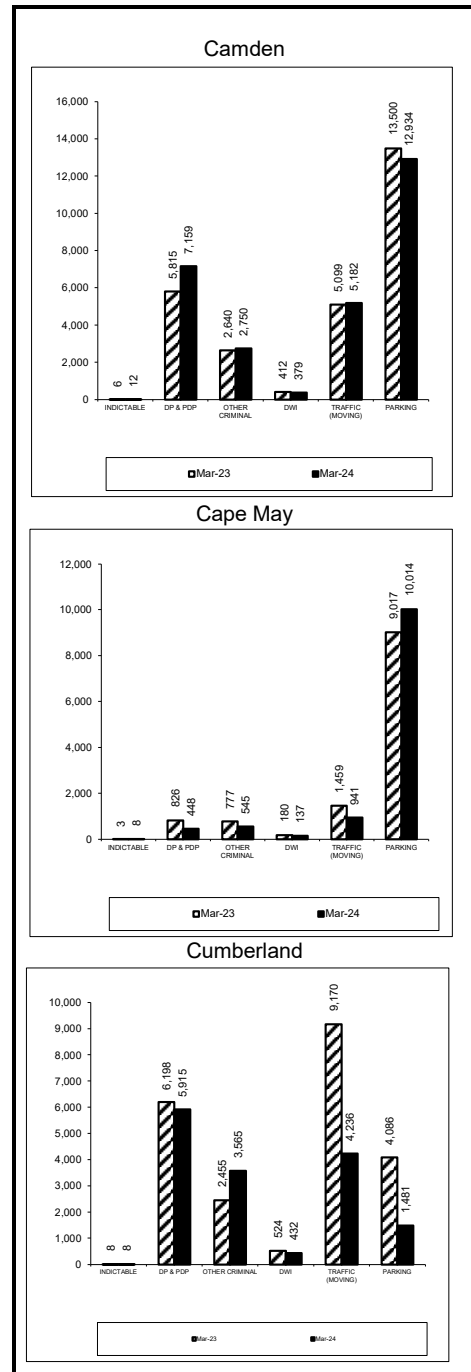

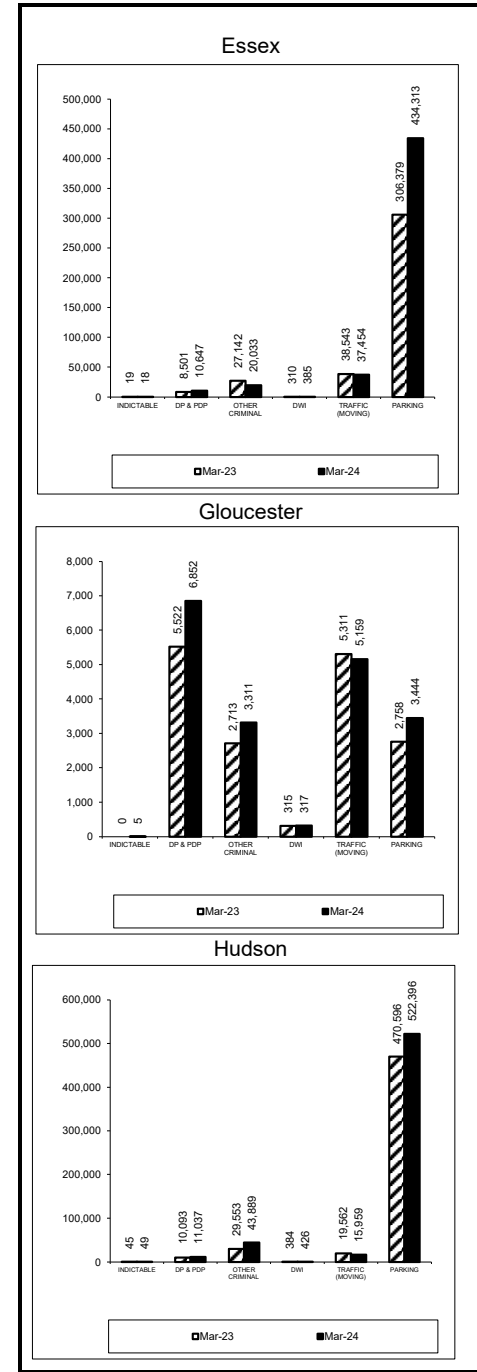

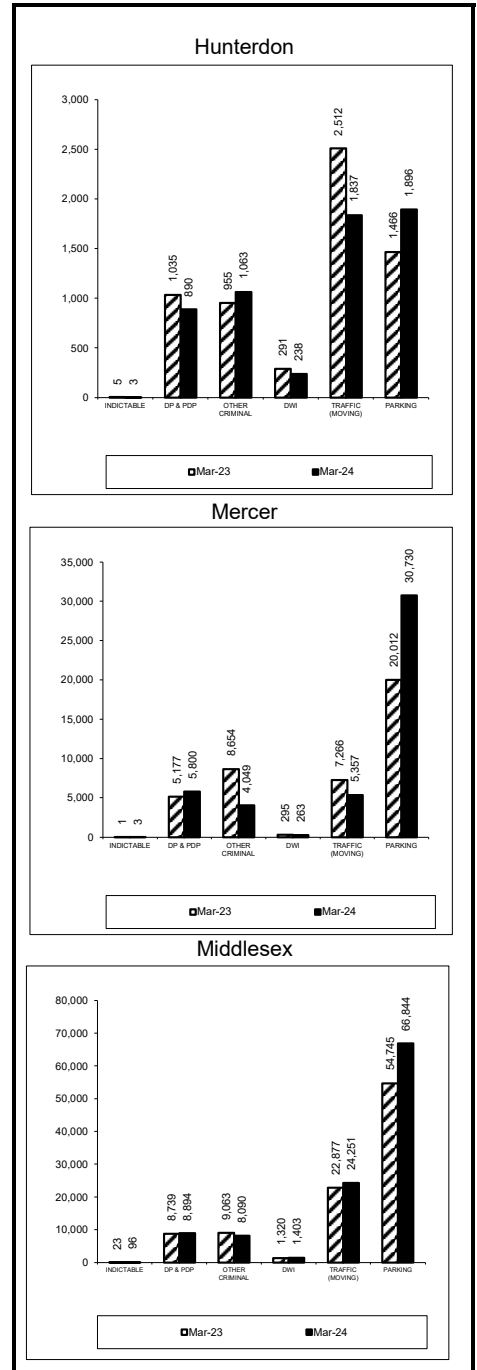

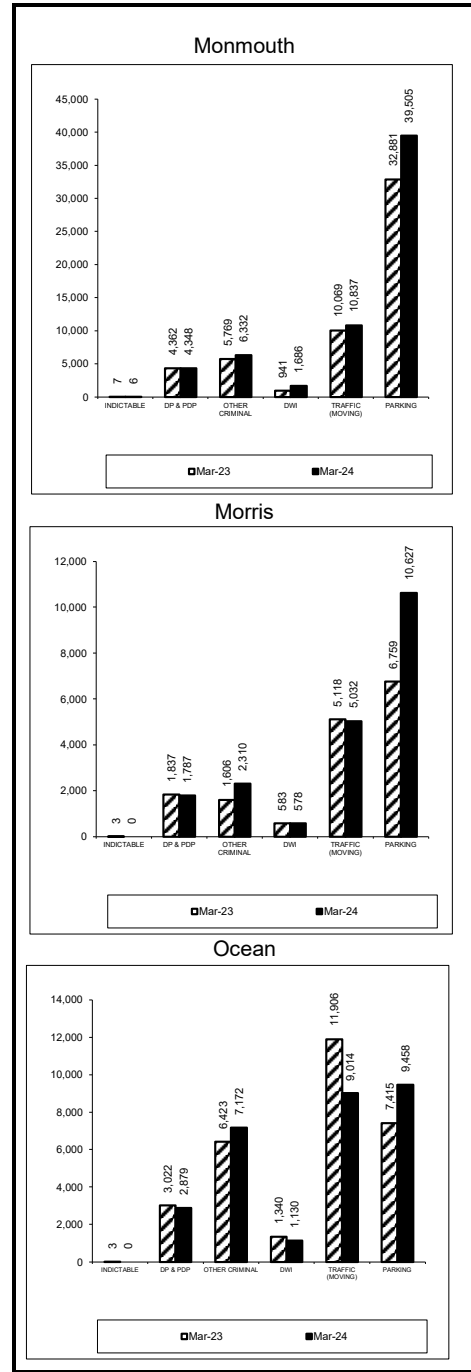

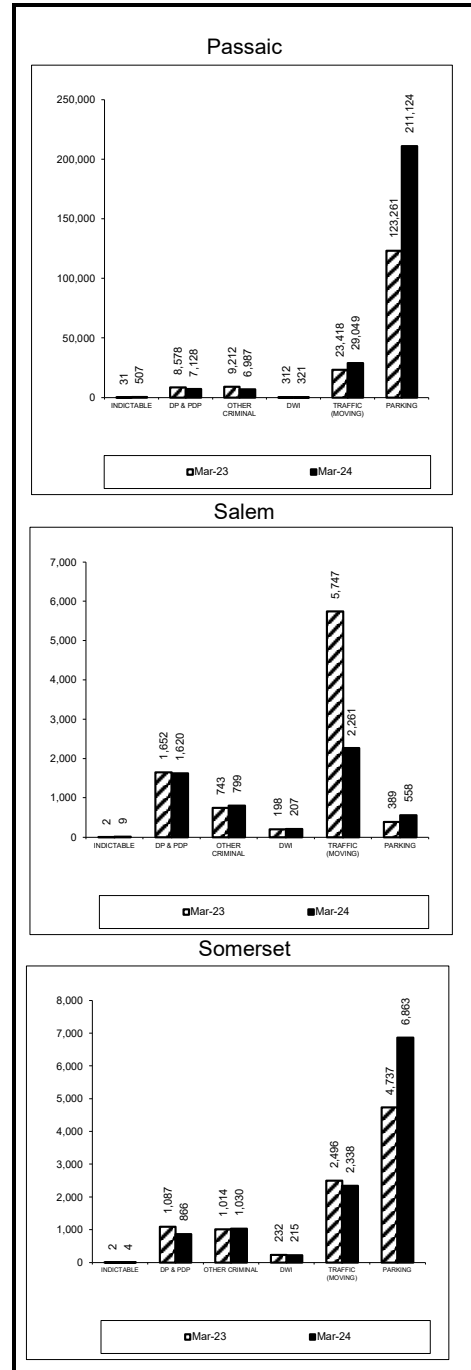

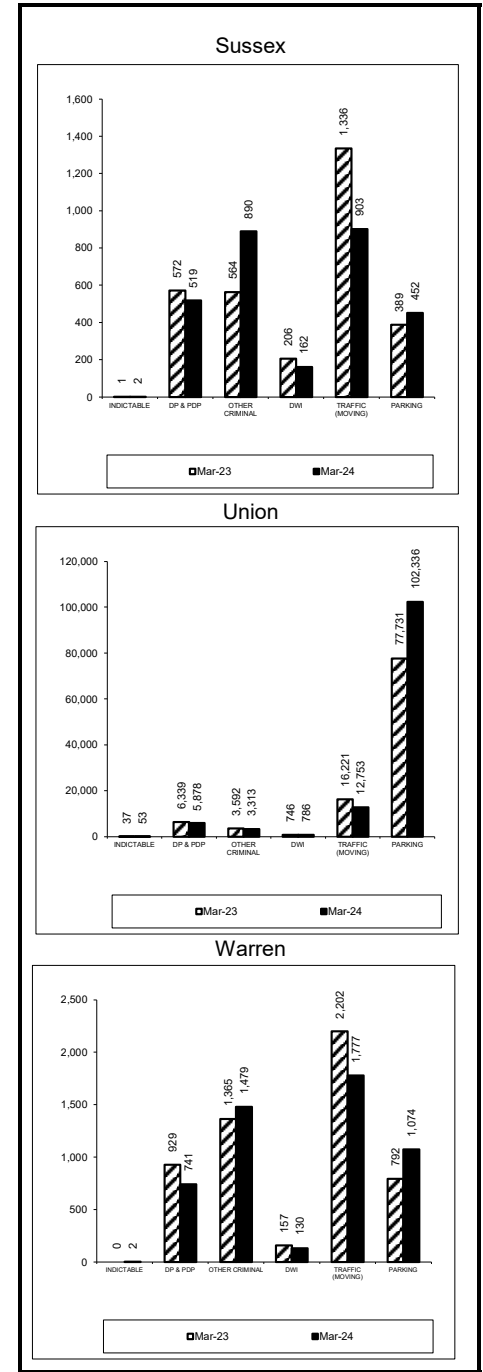

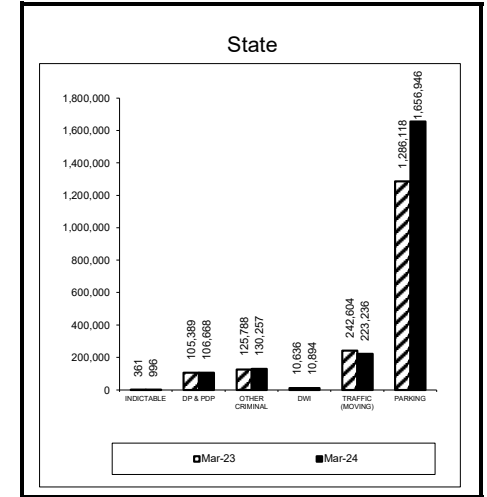

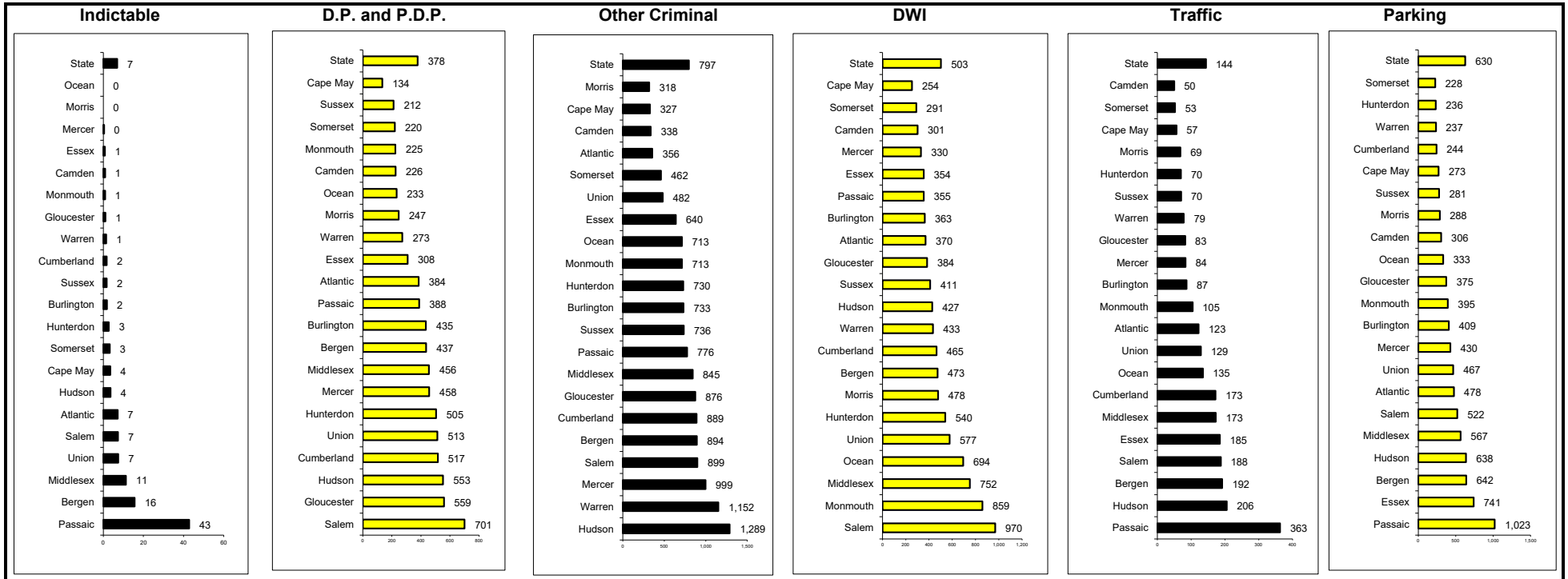
