


Guide to Accessing eCourts Appellate

Effective August 1, 2017, access to eCourts Appellate was granted to all NJ attorneys in good standing status as of June 30, 2017. If you are currently not in good standing status, you will need to be reinstated before access will be granted.

Step 1.

Activate your NJ Attorney ID. If you have never used the Attorney Registration and Contact Information online, go to [Attorney Registration & Contact Information](#) and follow the instructions for **First Time Users – One Time Account Setup**.

If you currently use the Online Registration and Payment Center, your NJ Attorney ID has been activated. Proceed to Step 2.

Your temporary password can be used only once. It expires when you create your permanent password. In the future, use your permanent password to login as a "returning user".

Firms/Individual Attorneys

1. Login with the unique **User ID and temporary password**.
2. Create your permanent password, make note of it for future use, and submit the requested basic data.
3. Go to your email inbox and click on the link in the activation email that you should have received. If there is no activation email, check your spam or junk folders, then contact us at CPF.Mailbox@njcourts.gov.
4. Add CPF.Mailbox@njcourts.gov to your Address Book to ensure that you receive future notices regarding the annual assessment.

Step 2.

Verify your contact information by logging into the <https://portal.njcourts.gov/webe3/sso> with your NJ Attorney Bar ID and password. This is the same User ID and Password used to log in and pay your annual attorney registration. Select the **Confirm or Update Contact Information** tab. The contact information currently on file in the Central Attorney Management System (CAMS) such as phone number, firm association and mailing address will automatically be used in eCourts Appellate.

1. Click the **Reset Password** button
2. Answer the security questions when prompted
3. An email will be sent to the email address used to activate the account
4. Open the email and follow the instructions
