

4:69-4. Filing and Management for Actions in Lieu of Prerogative Writs

The filing of the complaint shall be accompanied by a certification that all necessary transcripts of local agency proceedings in the cause have been ordered. All actions in lieu of prerogative writs will be assigned to Track IV. Within 30 days after joinder and in order to expedite the disposition of the action the managing judge shall conduct a conference, in person or by telephone, with all parties to determine the factual and legal disputes, to mark exhibits and to establish a briefing schedule [and, if necessary, a discovery schedule]. The scope and time to complete discovery, if any, will be determined at the case management conference and memorialized in the case management order. At least five days in advance of the conference, each party shall submit to the managing judge a statement of factual and legal issues and an exhibit list.
