3. notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing before this Court; and
4. have all pleadings and other papers filed in this Court signed by an attorney-at-law of this Court employed by the firm of Seeger Weiss LLP, who shall be responsible for the conduct of Andrew H. Bate, Esq., and it is further

**ORDERED** that Andrew H. Bate, Esq., shall make payment of fees as provided in the New Jersey Rules of Court, R. 1:28-1(b), 1:28-2 and 1:28b-1(e), within thirty (30) days of the date of this order, and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and it is further

**ORDERED** that copies of this Order shall be served by attorneys for Plaintiff upon counsel for the defendants within seven (7) days of the receipt thereof.
