**JOINT STIPULATION AND ORDER**

On February 3, 2017, Defendant Schwarz Pharma, Inc. n/k/a UCB, Inc. (“Schwarz”) and counsel for those plaintiffs who have thus far agreed to settle with Schwarz submitted a Joint Stipulation and Order (“February 3 Stipulation”) to the Court containing certain stipulations as between them addressing the resolution of settling plaintiffs’ claims asserted against Schwarz and the effectuation of the agreed to settlement. Plaintiff Theresa Miller (“Plaintiff”), who has agreed to settle with Schwarz, was inadvertently omitted from the February 3 Stipulation. Accordingly, Schwarz and counsel for Plaintiff hereby fully incorporate the February 3 Stipulation<sup>1</sup>, including the stipulations contained therein.

IT IS SO STIPULATED.

Now therefore:

1. Pursuant to this Joint Stipulation and Order and the accompanying Order of Disposition (annexed hereto as Exhibit 1) it is hereby Ordered that all claims asserted against Schwarz, by or on behalf of Plaintiff Theresa Miller are hereby dismissed with prejudice, with each side to bear its own costs and fees in accordance with the Release; and



2. Pursuant to this Joint Stipulation and Order it is hereby Ordered that the only remedy or recourse for Plaintiff Theresa Miller to resolve her individual claims against Schwarz are the funds that Schwarz deposits into the Qualified Settlement Fund under the Master Settlement Agreement.




