IT IS ON THIS 8<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2011



2. consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme court as a agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against her or her firm that may arise out of her participation in this matter;
3. notify the Court immediately of any other matter affecting her standing before this Court; and
4. have all pleadings and other papers filed in this Court signed by an attorney-at-law of this Court employed by the firm of Finkelstein & Partners, LLP, who shall be responsible for the conduct for Mary Ellen Wright, Esq. and it further
