

COVID-19 FILING INFORMATION FOR STATE TAX AND LOCAL PROPERTY TAX COMPLAINTS

Because of concerns relating to the COVID-19 public health crisis and the current State of Emergency in New Jersey, you should not visit Tax Court Judges' Chambers or the Clerk's Office for the foreseeable future. **If you must deliver papers, call the Tax Court Management Office at call 609 815-2922, Ext. 54650 in advance to arrange for drop off.**

We strongly urge you to use a Judiciary online electronic application to file your documents. If you are a first time user, you must register before filing. Your ID and password will work for either system set out below.

- If you are filing a local property tax complaint, you should use eCourts Tax. Do not use JEDS to file a local property tax appeal.
- If you are filing a State tax complaint, you should use the JEDS system. ***JEDS is for filing a state tax complaint only. Once you receive your docket number, use eCourts Tax to file additional documents.***

You can also mail your paper filing via regular postal service to Tax Court Management Office, P.O. Box 972, Trenton, NJ 08625. Your documents will be processed as quickly as possible. You will be sent a notice regarding filing fees or other issues.
