

**COVID-19 FILING INFORMATION FOR STATE TAX  
COMPLAINTS AND SELF-REPRESENTED TAX COURT  
LITIGANTS**

Because of concerns relating to the COVID-19 coronavirus public health crisis and the current State of Emergency in New Jersey, you should not come to Tax Court Judges' Chambers or the Clerk's Office for the foreseeable future. **If you must deliver papers, you must call the Tax Court Management Office at call 609-815-2922 Ext. 54650 in advance to arrange for drop off.**

We strongly urge you to use an electronic alternative means of delivering your documents. You may:

- **Fax your documents to 609-376-3019.**

**If you are unable to email or fax your documents you can mail your paper filings via regular postal service to Tax Court Management Office, P.O. Box 972, Trenton, NJ 08625**

Your documents will be processed as quickly as practicable. You will be sent a notice regarding filing fees or other issues.

By Order of the Chief Justice dated March 19, 2020, time for filing complaints and counterclaims has been extended to the later of May 1, 2020 or 30 days following a determination by the Governor that the State of Emergency declared under Executive Order No. 103 has ended.
