



Plaintiffs served the individual defendants on November 1, 2016. On January 17, 2017, default was entered. Plaintiffs now seek default judgment against the individual defendants. Included among the damages sought are monetary amounts against each individual defendant, and various requests for declaratory and injunctive relief.

As the monetary amounts are not liquidated amounts, but rather seek non-economic losses for pain and suffering, they are all subject to a proof hearing. As the other relief sought may or may not be within the individual defendants' authority to perform or provide, a proof hearing must also be held.

Accordingly, the motion for default judgment in the fixed amounts claimed, and for the remaining relief sought, is denied without prejudice, in favor of a required proof hearing.

The Court is now aware that a motion has been filed on behalf of the defaulted parties to vacate the default, which is opposed and which is scheduled for oral argument on Friday March 31, 2017.
