THIS MATTER having been brought before the Court by Plaintiffs, The Wolf Law Firm, LLC and The Law Office Of Christopher J. McGinn, by their attorney, Kelly Samuels Thomas, Esq. of The Wolf Law Firm, LLC, appearing, and the Court having reviewed the moving papers and any opposition thereto, and the Court having heard the argument of counsel and/or conducted a hearing on 3/31, 2017; and for other good cause appearing,

IT IS, on this 31st day of March, 2017, **ORDERED** that:

1. Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment is hereby **GRANTED**;
