Statement of Reasons

1. Defendant NJM comes before the Court seeking two orders in aid of litigant's rights, against Inderjit Kainth M.D. and Endo Surgical Center respectively, for failure to provide requested medical records. Defendant requests the Court order the appearance of a doctor in first application and a business entity in the second motion. The motions seek an order to show cause why the court should not impose penalty or sanction, including but not limited to an order for contempt of court, fine, or other action, if the requested documents are not provided. Further, Defendant requested that should the above persons fail to appear, a warrant may be issued for their arrest.
2. Rule 1:9-3 provides "[a] subpoena may be served by any person 18 or more years of age. Service of a subpoena shall be made by delivering a copy thereof to the person named together with tender of the fee allowed by law..."
3. Rule 1:10-3 allows for a party to seek aid of litigant's rights to enforce their right to obtain discovery from parties and non-parties alike. This rule does not apply to orders that cannot be enforced due to lack of in personam jurisdiction, such as where a party fails to properly serve the person from whom relief is sought. NJ Cure v. Estate of Hamilton, 407 N.J. Super. 247, 251-252 (App. Div. 2009). "The general rule is that a court does not possess the right or power to punish for contempt in disregard or in violation of its order which was entered without jurisdiction over the subject matter or the parties or without power or authority to enter the particular order." Id. at 252.
4. Rule 4:4-4 prescribes the methods of service upon which Defendant, and the Court, can obtain in personam Jurisdiction. See NJ Cure v. Estate of Hamilton, 407 N.J. Super. 247, 251 (App. Div. 2009).
5. Defendant attempted to serve Endo Surgical Center by personally serving Ray Laury, "Front Desk Manager" at its office in Clifton, New Jersey. Defendant attempted to serve Inderjit Kainth M.D. by personally serving Sunrita Mitra, the receptionist at Dr. Kainth's Kendal Park, New Jersey office.

Here, the Court finds that it lacks personal jurisdiction over both non-parties as service did not conform to the Court Rules. Rule 1:9-3 requires tender of the allowed fee with the subpoena, however it does not appear from the record that either non-party received said fee. Further, the Court questions the propriety of service upon the "receptionist" or "front desk manager" for purposes of service under Rules 1:9-3 and 4:4-4(a) particularly in light of the due process concerns where the threat of arrest entails. Accordingly, service upon both individuals was deficient for failure to tender the required fees.

6. Rule 1:9-3 requires that “personal” service be just that, directed and served upon “the person named.” NJ Cure v. Estate of Hamilton, 407 N.J. Super. 247, 251 (App. Div. 2009). Our Appellate Division has previously found that Rule 4:4-4(a) should guide our review of an order to show cause in aid of litigants rights. Id.

The legal status of the party to be served determines what methods of service may be utilized. Rule 4:4-4(a). Here, it is unclear what the legal status Endo Surgical Center is, whether it is a sole proprietorship, partnership, unincorporated association, or other corporate entity.

Regardless, Defendant would be required to affect personal service upon an individual authorized to receive service, whether that be the owner, partner, director, or managing or general agent, etc. depending on the applicable rule. Here, the Court finds service on Endo Surgical Center was deficient, as Mr. Laury, in his position as “Front Desk Manager”, does not appear from the record to have been acting in the capacity of a managing or general agent or person otherwise authorized to receive service. For those same reasons, the Court finds that service upon Dr. Inderjit Kainth through “receptionist” Sunrita Mitra, is also deficient.

7. Accordingly, for the reasons stated above, Defendant NJM’s two motions to enforce litigant’s rights are denied for improper service. If Defendant seeks to renew this application, it should be accompanied by a brief in support of said motion articulating a basis in law or court rule that addresses the above concerns.
