It is on this 21st day of JUNE 2017;

ORDERED that Count 1 of Plaintiff's First Amended Complaint for plaintiff's claims of unlawful disability discrimination and/or harassment are dismissed with prejudice and without costs and fees; and it is further

ORDERED that the fact that plaintiff has consented to the dismissal of Count 1 will not have an affect on what evidence may be introduced at time of trial. The parties reserve all rights to object to the admissibility of any proffered evidence at the time of trial. These decisions will be made by the trial judge; and it is further

ORDERED that to the extent that Count 4 claims hostile work environment with regard to Defendants those claims are dismissed with prejudice and without costs and fees; and it is further

ORDERED that the defendants' motion to dismiss the plaintiff's claims for unlawful retaliation and failure to accommodate his disability in Counts 2 and 3 and plaintiff's remaining claims against Brian Latham in Count 4 are denied; and it is further


ORDERED that plaintiff's claims for failure to promote are dismissed with prejudice and without costs and fees; and it is further

ORDERED that the defendants' motion to dismiss the plaintiff's punitive damages claims is denied without prejudice; and it is further


ORDERED that the defendants' application to seal records submitted by the plaintiff on the summary judgment motion is granted; and it is further

ORDERED that a copy of the within Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date hereof.


