

Automatic termination of *pro hac vice* admission shall occur for failure to make the required annual payment of the annual fee and the annual payment to the Lawyer's Assistance Fund, the Disciplinary Oversight Committee and the New Jersey Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection. Proof of such payment, after filing proof of the initial payment, shall be made no later than February 1st of each year; and

10. Noncompliance with any of these requirements shall constitute grounds for removal; and
