



WHAT IS A COURTHOUSE?





When you walk into the Courthouse, you may see people who look like police officers.


These people are called **SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES**

You also may have to walk through a **METAL DETECTOR**, just like at the airport. This machine is also there for safety reasons.







The Judge's gavel and law books




This is where the jury sits




