Rule 3.17(B)(6);

And the Court having determined pursuant to Rule 2:15-17(a), that there is

probable cause to conclude that respondent has violated the Code of Judicial

Conduct, and that her continued service while disciplinary proceedings are pending

would pose a substantial threat of serious harm to the administration of justice,

And good cause appearing;

IT IS ORDERED that Municipal Court Judge Aishaah A. Rasul is suspended from the exercise of her judicial duties, without pay, effective immediately, pending expedited proceedings before the Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct and until the further Order of the Court.
