ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

A Judge of the Superior Court :

The Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct having filed with the Court pursuant to Rule 2:15-15 (a), a presentment in respect of **Arthur Bergman**, a Judge of the Superior Court, finding by clear and convincing evidence that while a Judge of the Superior Court, respondent violated the following Canons and Rules of the Code of Judicial Conduct: Canon 1, Rule 1.1; Canon 2, Rule 2.1; and Canon 3, Rule 3.6 (C); and Rule 3.8;

And the Committee having recommended to the Court that **Arthur Bergman** be publicly reprimanded;

And **Arthur Bergman** having filed with the Court a motion to dismiss the presentment pursuant to Rule 2:15-16;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that pursuant to Rule 2:15-17 (b) (2), **Arthur Bergman** show cause why he should not be disciplined with a sanction that is less than removal from judicial office; and it is further

ORDERED that Candace Moody, Esq., or her designee, present this matter to the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that this matter be set down for oral argument on the presentment and on respondent's motion to dismiss on September 28, 2022, at a time to be determined by the Court, in the Supreme Court Courtroom, Richard J. Hughes Justice Complex, Trenton.
