The Probation Acknowledgment form should only be used for cases where a Warrant to Satisfy Judgment does not include a section for Probation Child Support Enforcement (PCSE) staff to indicate the following:

- the judgment has been satisfied
- Probation will no longer be monitoring or enforcing the case, and
- a signature of the Vicinage Chief Probation Officer (VCPO) or Authorized Probation Manager.

Attach the Probation Acknowledgment form to the Warrant to Satisfy Judgment and proceed with the standard procedures located under *Probation Child Support Enforcement Operations Manual*, Section 1607 Judgment Procedures.
