5. Order Mandating Release of NGRI Acquittee

The following order is to be used when the court finds that the NGRI acquittee is not so dangerous to self, others, or property as to require institutionalization or release upon certain conditions. In such cases the acquittee is released with no conditions pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:4-8(b)(1).

In accordance with <u>State v. Ortiz</u>, 193 N.J. 278 (2008), the court no longer has jurisdiction and there are no further hearings or review under N.J.S.A. 2C:4-8.
