Wyly, Esq.; the Court having considered the papers in support thereof; and the Court having found that James C. Wyly, Esq., is a member in good standing of the bar of the highest Court in the State where he is domiciled and principally practices law and further good cause shown,

IT IS ON THIS 19 day of Sept, 2005

ORDERED that the Motion is granted and James C. Wyly, Esq., is admitted to practice *Pro Hac Vice* before this Court pursuant to R. 1:21-2, for all purposes and in all proceedings in connection with this action, all actions currently pending in the Accutane Litigation, and any further such actions filed in this court in the same manner as an attorney who is admitted to

1. abide by the Rules of Court for the State of New Jersey, including all disciplinary rules;
2. consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as an agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against him and his firm that may arise out of his participation in this matter;
3. notify the Court immediately of any matter effecting his standing before this Court; and
4. have all pleadings and other papers filed in this Court signed by an attorney-at-law of this Court employed by the firm of Seeger Weiss LLP, who shall be responsible for the conduct of James C. Wyly, Esq., and it is further

ORDERED that James C. Wyly, Esq., shall make payment of fees as provided in the New Jersey Rules of Court, R. 1:28-1(b), 1:28-2 and 1:28b-1(e) and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and it is further
