THIS MATTER being opened to the Court by Leonard Z. 4. Have all pleadings and other papers filed in this Court signed by an attorney-at-law of this Court employed by Cohn, Lifland, Pearlman, Herrmann & Knopf, LLP, who shall be responsible for the conduct of Aaron R. Dias; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Aaron R. Dias shall make payment of fees as provided in the New Jersey Rules of Court, R.1:28-1(b), 1:28-2 and 1:28b-1(e) within 30 days of the date of this Order; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and it is
