**ORDER ADMITTING MARK W.

AND NOW, Gibbons, Del Deo, Dolan, Griffinger & Vecchione, P.C., counsel for Defendants Hoffmann-La Roche Inc. and Roche Laboratories Inc. ("Roche"), upon notice to all interested parties, have moved before this Court for admission *pro hac vice* of Mark W. Farris, Esq.; the Court having considered the papers in support thereof; and the Court having found that Mark W. Farris, Esq. is a member in good standing for the bar of the highest Court in the State where Mark W. Farris, Esq. resides and principally practices law and further good cause shown,

IT IS on this 28 day of November, 2006,

**ORDERED** that the Motion is granted and Mark W. Farris, Esq. is admitted to practice *pro hac vice* before this Court pursuant to R. 1:21-2 for all purposes and in all proceedings in connection with the actions listed on Schedule A, provided that Mark W. Farris, Esq. shall:

2. consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as an agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against Mark W. Farris, Esq. and Mark W. Farris's firm that may arise out of Mark W. Farris's participation in these matters;

3. notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting Mark W. Farris's standing before this Court; and
4. have all pleadings and other papers filed in the Court signed by an attorney-at-law of this Court employed by the firm Gibbons, Del Deo, Dolan, Griffinger & Vecchione, P.C., who shall be responsible for the conduct of Mark W. Farris, Esq.; and it is further

**ORDERED** that Mark W. Farris shall make payment of fees as provided in the New Jersey Rules of Court, R. 1:28-1(b), 1:28-2 and 1:28B-1(e), within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and it is further

**ORDERED** that copies of this Order shall be served by attorneys for Roche upon the members of the Accutane Counsel List, which was last updated on July 28, 2006, within seven (7) days of the receipt thereof.
