ORDERED as follows:

- (1) The application for admission *pro hac vice* of Mary Rose Alexander, Esq. shall be

and hereby is granted.

- (2) The attorney admitted *pro hac vice* shall:
 - (a) abide by the Rules Governing the Courts of the State of New Jersey, including all disciplinary Rules;
 - (b) consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against her or her firm that may arise out of her participation in this matter;
 - (c) notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting her standing at the bar of any Court; and
 - (d) have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this State, who shall be held responsible for her and for the conduct of the cause and of the admitted attorneys therein; and
 - (e) within 10 days of this Order, shall pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b), R. 1:28B-1(e), and R. 1:28-2, and shall submit an affidavit of compliance, and annually thereafter while still admitted *pro hac vice*.
- (3) The Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection.
- (4) This Order has been uploaded by the Court to the eCourts case jacket. Counsel for the moving party shall serve a copy of this Order on any party who did not receive an electronic notice of this filing within 7 days of the date of this Order.
