CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER No. 8

THIS MATTER having come before the Court by agreement of the parties, concerning an extension of certain dates in Case Management Order No. 6, and counsel having agreed to the schedule changes set forth in this Order, and the Court having discussed the schedule changes with the parties at the Case Management Conference held on May 19, 2015, and good cause having been shown;

IT IS on this 2nd day of June, 2015,


ORDERED as follows:

1. This Case Management Order shall supersede any conflicting provisions in any preceding Case Management Order.
2. Experts' depositions shall be completed on or before June 25, 2015, with the exception of the deposition of Dr. Thomas Gouge, which shall be completed on or before July 3, 2015.
3. Dispositive motions (including motions based upon the statute of limitations) and motions relating to the admissibility of expert testimony (Kemp/N.J.R.E. 702) in the four (4) bellwether trial cases shall be served and filed with the Court no later than noon on the dates set forth below:
 - (a) Motions: no later than; **Friday, July 10, 2015;**
 - (b) Oppositions: no later than **Friday, July 24, 2015;**

- (c) Replies: no later than **Friday, July 31, 2015**; and
- (d) Oral argument and/or hearing: to be scheduled by the Court if deemed necessary.

4. Except as modified by paragraphs 2 and 3 above, all other provisions in Case Management Order Nos. 6 and 7 shall remain in effect.

5. The Court shall post a copy of this order online within seven (7) days of the date of this order.
