**ORDER  
RE: FILING OF VOLUNTARY  
STIPULATIONS OF DISMISSAL**

**It is on this 5th day of January, 2015;**

**ORDERED:**

The procedure for the filing of Voluntary Stipulations of Dismissal as set forth by e-mail of March 28, 2012 is hereby rescinded.

Effective immediately, if a plaintiff and a defendant enter into a Stipulation of Dismissal, same shall be filed directly with the Multi-County Litigation Clerk's Office.

If a defendant thereafter seeks a dismissal as to cross-claims, a letter application shall be filed directly with the asbestos judge's chambers. That letter application shall set forth the relief requested upon ten (10) days' notice to all counsel of record in that case. The application shall include a copy of the "filed" Stipulation of Dismissal between plaintiff and the moving party, a Certification of Service along with a copy of the current counsel list for that case, and a proposed form of Order along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

While a Voluntary Stipulation of Dismissal as to a "closed" case may be filed with the Clerk's Office, the Court will not execute an Order of Dismissal as to cross-claims in "closed" cases.
