- 1. On the first business day following entry of this Order, all Plaintiff discovery responses, including Plaintiff Profile Forms and attachments thereto (i.e. medical records, plaintiff-provided records, authorizations, etc.) and Plaintiff responses to deficiency letters (hereinafter collectively "Discovery Responses") shall be sent by the Plaintiff in accordance with this Order via either email or, if physically, as specified in paragraph 3.
