IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

ORDER CONCERNING LIAISON COUNSEL AND INITIAL DISCOVERY

- 1. There are matters common among all plaintiffs that require the coordinated efforts of the various plaintiffs' counsel that have filed actions in these coordinated proceedings, including discovery, communications with the Court, and motion practice, and the appointment of liaison counsel would aid in these efforts.
- 2. Christopher A. Seeger, Esq., of the law firm Seeger Weiss LLP, has substantial experience in prosecuting coordinated proceedings in mass torts in New Jersey and in other jurisdictions, and is hereby appointed Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel.
- 3. Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel shall (1) serve as the primary contacts for communication between the Court and other plaintiffs' counsel; (2) ensure that all notices, orders, and material communications are properly distributed (to the extent they are not otherwise served on plaintiffs' counsel); (3) convene meetings of counsel; (4) maintain and make

available to other plaintiffs' counsel documents produced by defendant; and (5) otherwise assist in the coordination of activities and positions of plaintiffs in the FOSAMAX litigation.

4. Eileen Oakes Muskett, Esquire, has substantial experience in the handling of

complex litigation in Atlantic County Superior Court, in the Federal District Court of New Jersey

5. Upon entry of an approved Confidentiality Order, defendant shall promptly

produce copies of all non-case-specific materials produced in the Fosamax Products Liability
