- (3) Mr. Climaco shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction;
- (4) Mr. Climaco shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with this Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation, and Mr. Climaco, the attorney admitted herein;
  - (5) Mr. Climaco cannot be designated as trial counsel;
- (6) No discovery, motion, trial or any other proceeding delay shall occur or be requested by reason of the inability of Mr. Climaco to be in attendance;
- (7) Mr. Climaco must, within ten (10) days, pay the fees required by  $\underline{\mathbf{R}}$ . 1:20-1(b) and  $\underline{\mathbf{R}}$ . 1:28-2 and submit an affidavit of compliance;
- (8) Pro hac vice admission will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payment required by  $\underline{R}$ . 1:20-1(b) and  $\underline{R}$ . 1:28-2;
- (9) Non-compliance with any of the terms of this order shall constitute grounds for removal; and it is further

**ORDERED** that a copy of this Order shall be served upon all parties within seven (7) days from the date hereof.
