3. MICHAEL JUSTIN LUSKO, ESQ. shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any court; and

4. MICHAEL JUSTIN LUSKO, ESQ. shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice law in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for the cases and for the conduct of Scott Levensten therein.

ORDERED that MICHAEL JUSTIN LUSKO, ESQ. must, within thirty (30) days, submit a copy of this Order and pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b), R. 1:28-2 and 1:28B-1(e), and it is further

ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
