THIS MATTER having come before the Court during the September 20, 2017 Case Management Conference, and for good cause shown,

1. By <u>September 27, 2017</u>, Napoli Shkolnik PLLC and Marc J. Bern & Partners LLP shall provide to the Court and defense counsel an update regarding the status of their collective resolved case inventory and advise of any issues which stand in the way of prompt consummation of the agreed upon settlement.

2. Defendants' request for leave to file a motion for summary judgment in the <u>Warnet</u> (MID-L-9956-14) matter is hereby GRANTED. Defendants shall file the motion <u>on</u> <u>October 13, 2017</u> by noon.

3. Defendants' request for leave to file a motion for summary judgment in the <u>Haynes</u> (M1D-L-9755-14) matter is hereby GRANTED. Defendants shall file the motion <u>by</u> October 13, 2017 at noon.

4. Defendants' request for leave to file motions to dismiss in the <u>Beato</u> (MID-L-9796-14), <u>Zech</u> (MID-L-9947-14), <u>Skawinski</u> (MID-L-9763-14) and <u>Shelley</u> (MID-L-10034-14) matters is hereby GRANTED. Defendants shall file the motions <u>by October 13, 2017</u> at noon.

5. By October 11, 2017, plaintiff's counsel in <u>Hall</u> (MID-L-9962-14) shall provide a date for plaintiff's deposition to take place in New Jersey or, if plaintiff is unable to travel to New Jersey for her deposition, counsel shall produce a detailed note from plaintiff's physician setting forth the specific reason(s) she is unable to travel.

6. In the <u>Arthur</u> (MID-L-10033-14), <u>Costello</u> (MID-L-9896-14), <u>Dermody</u> (MID-L-9739-14), <u>Lynn</u> (MID-L-9906-14), <u>O'Connor</u> (MID-L-10039-14), <u>Rappoport</u> (MID-L-10038-14) and <u>Utz</u> (MID-L-9959-14) matters, counsel shall work together to schedule prescribing and/or treating physician depositions for mutually convenient dates as soon as practicable, to take place no later than <u>November 30, 2017</u>. If dates cannot be set or any physician will not appear voluntarily, defendants shall make the proper application for service of subpoenas.

7. By <u>September 27, 2017</u>, plaintiff's counsel in the <u>Brooks</u> (MID-L-9902-14) matter shall provide defendants with an executed stipulation of dismissal with prejudice.

8. Plaintiff's counsel in the <u>Lewy</u> (MID-L-9910-14) matter shall provide defendants with a date for plaintiff's deposition to be conducted in New Jersey by <u>November 30, 2017</u>.

9. Plaintiff's counsel in the <u>Krzyzkowski</u> (MID-L-9764-14) matter shall provide defendants with a date for Jarina Krzyzkowski's deposition to be conducted in New Jersey by <u>October 30, 2017</u>.
