ORDERED that if Plaintiff Courtney Renee Hay fails to provide a Completed Plaintiff
Fact Sheet containing all Core Criteria within 90 days from the date of this Order, Defendant
may file a Motion to Dismiss this action with prejudice; and it is further

ORDERED that a signed copy of this Order be served upon all counsel within seven (7)
days of the date hereof.
