THIS MATTER having come before the Court on the motion of defendants Sofradim Production and Tissue Science Laboratories for an Order admitting attorney Jane Bartley, Esquire of Shook Hardy & Bacon, LLP in Kansas City, Missouri, *pro hac vice* in the case listed on Schedule A attached hereto; and the Court having read and considered all submissions in connection with application; and no timely objection having been received; and good cause appearing;

IT IS on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2015,

**ORDERED** that Jane Bartley, Esquire be admitted *pro hac vice* and is authorized to appear and participate with other counsel for defendants Sofradim Production and Tissue Science Laboratories in all phases of the case, subject to the following conditions:

1. Jane Bartley shall abide by the Rules Governing the Courts of the State of New Jersey, including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2.

2. Jane Bartley shall and does hereby consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as her agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against her or her firm that may arise out of his participation in this matter.

3. Jane Bartley shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting her standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.

4. Jane Bartley shall have all pleadings, briefs, and other papers filed with the court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in New Jersey who shall be held responsible for her, the conduct of the litigation, and of the admitted attorneys herein.

5. Jane Bartley cannot be designated as trial counsel.

6. No delay in discovery, motions, trial, or any other proceeding shall occur or be requested by reason of the inability of Jane Bartley to be in attendance.

7. Jane Bartley or Stradley Ronon Stevens & Young, LLP, on her behalf, shall pay the fee required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2 within 10 days upon receipt of this Order, and shall submit an affidavit of compliance.

8. *Pro hac vice* admission will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payment required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2.

9. Non-compliance with any of these requirements shall constitute grounds of revocation of Jane Bartley *pro hac vice* admission.

10. A copy of this Order shall be served on all counsel of record within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
