FURTHER ORDERED that Michael K. Brown, Esq. shall:


1. Abide by the New Jersey Rules of Court, including all disciplinary rules;
2. Consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against her that may arise out of her participation in this matter;
3. Notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting her standing at the bar of any court; and
4. Have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in New Jersey, who shall be responsible for her and for the conduct of the cause; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the admission of Michael K. Brown, Esq. is subject to any conditions imposed by the judge hearing the trial of this matter; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the admission of Michael K. Brown, Esq. shall not in any way delay the trial of this matter, nor serve as the basis for any application for adjournment of trial of this matter; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Michael K. Brown, Esq. will make all required payments to the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection within 7 days hereof and shall annually comply with R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2 during the period of his admission; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel within seven (7) days of the date of this Order.
