3. Notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting him standing at the Bar of any other court;
4. Have all pleadings, briefs, and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this State, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the case, and the attorney admitted herein;

FURTHER ORDERED that the admission of Sean Jessee, Esq. is subject to any conditions imposed by the judge hearing the trial of this matter; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the admission of Sean Jessee, Esq. shall not in any way delay the trial of this matter, nor serve as a basis for any application for adjournment of trial of this matter; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel within seven (7) days of the date of this Order.
