CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 5 (PFS/ ETHICON DEFENDANTS' DFS ENABLING ORDER)

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on July 21, 2011, and counsel for Plaintiffs and counsel for Ethicon, Inc. and Johnson & Johnson ("Defendants") having been present and for good cause shown,

IT IS ON THIS \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 2011

**ORDERED** as follows,

1. For all cases filed as of the date of this Order (with the exception of cases in which plaintiffs have been deposed), Plaintiffs shall provide completed Plaintiff Fact Sheets ("PFS," annexed hereto as Exhibit 1) based on the number of cases being handled by the plaintiffs' counsel, as follows:

- a. 10 or fewer cases = 45 days
- b. 20 or fewer cases = 60 days
- c. 30 or fewer cases = 75 days
- d. Greater than 30 cases = 90 days

- 2. Plaintiffs and their counsel shall make a good faith effort to serve the completed PFS on a rolling basis to avoid unnecessary burden on Defendants that would result if all PFS statements are served upon Defendants on the same or last day of the periods set forth in Paragraph 1, above.
- 3. Defendants shall produce completed Defendants' Fact Sheets ("DFS", annexed hereto as Exhibit 2) in response to materially completed corresponding PFS's referenced in Paragraph 1, above, within 60 days of receipt.
- 4. For all cases filed after the date of this Order, Plaintiffs shall provide a completed PFS, no later than 45 days after the date of filing their complaint, and Defendants shall served a completed DFS within 45 days of service of the completed PFS.
- 5. For the plaintiffs who have been deposed, Defendants shall serve DFS forms within 60 days after the entry of this Order. Defendants have requested completed PFS forms for these plaintiffs and the parties will meet and confer with regard to the extent to which truncated Plaintiff Fact Sheets will be provided.
- 6. The parties met and conferred and understand that the timing of service of the PFS and the scope of certain of the information that may need to be gathered to complete the corresponding DFS may vary significantly. The parties have represented that they shall grant reasonable requests for extensions as needed, on a case-by-case basis.
- 7. Service of all PFS and DFS shall be made via email and hardcopy to the attorney(s) designated by Defendants, the designated Plaintiffs' Liaison Counsel, and the lead plaintiffs counsel of record for the individual case, respectively.

Associated document productions shall be made simultaneously consistent with the format agreed to by the parties. Defendants' liaison counsel and Plaintiffs' liaison counsel shall jointly maintain a list/log tracking service dates for PFS and DFS forms.

- 8. Production of Defendants' Fact Sheets shall not be delayed due to technical deficiencies in a PFS (e.g., missing telephone number, economic information to be supplied), but Plaintiffs understand that certain information must be supplied by Plaintiffs in the PFS in order for Defendants to provide a substantive response and Plaintiffs agree that missing information, whether substantive or "technical," must be supplied within a reasonable time period after service of the deficient PFS.
- hereby consent to the disclosure of the individual names and law firm names of all counsel representing Plaintiffs in this litigation, in unredacted form, in adverse event reports that Defendants produce to Plaintiffs as part of the DFS response process. Plaintiffs' counsel (both liaison and non-liaison counsel) acknowledge and agree that no additional consent forms are necessary to authorize this disclosure. This paragraph shall be binding upon all counsel for Plaintiffs in pending and future-filed cases in this litigation. In the event that the reporting party of an adverse event is an attorney who does not represent a Plaintiff in this litigation, and the appropriate authorization cannot be obtained from that reporting attorney, then the adverse event report will produced with only the name and identifying information of that reporting attorney redacted. Plaintiffs reserve the right to move at a later date for an unredacted copy of the adverse event report.

10. Case Management Order No. 3, entered and filed on June 1, 2011, is hereby amended as follows:

a. The following language is hereby added at the end of Paragraph 3:

"The parties further agree that if Defendants contest service, they shall raise that in the Short Form Answer or that defense shall be waived."

A revised Master Short Form Complaint (annexed hereto as Ъ. Exhibit 3) hereby replaces the Master Short Form Complaint previously served in this matter on June 2, 2011. The Master Short Form Complaint dated June 2, 2011 shall be removed from the Court's website. The revised Master Short Form Complaint shall be posted on the Court's website at: http://www/judiciary.state.nj.us/masstort/forms/index.htm. All individual complaints filed after the date of entry of this Order shall utilize the revised Master Short Form Complaint. The remaining provisions of Case Management Order No. 3 remain in full force and effect.
