Removal of case from discovery pool because it does not satisfy pool criteria in that it involves TVT and Gynemesh PS and also it appears that her mesh erosion was Gynemesh PS since it occurred at the site of the apex, which technically renders it a no revision case as to the TVT. Parties will meet and confer and provide the court with an update on whether this Plaintiff should be removed from the TVT retropubic discovery pool.
