III. CASE MANAGEMENT

- A. Status of the TVT-O cases the Court previously selected for an October 26, 2020 trial date:
 - 1. Farnsworth, Cheri Lynn & Leland, (BER-L-014433-14), Hecht Kleeger and Oshman & Mirisola. The Court has adjourned the trial scheduled for this case due to COVID-related circumstances. The parties reported that they currently are on schedule with the Eighth Amended Pretrial Order.

¹ Motion for Summary Judgment based on Statute of Limitations and Bankruptcy Judicial Estoppel filed with a briefing schedule that had been set forth in Consent Order dated 9/24/2020. The bankruptcy trustee, Henry J. Applewhite, has advised that the bankruptcy case has been reopened as of December 9, 2020, and the process to appoint counsel has been started. Thereafter, the applications will be made to substitute party in interest. The parties intend to submit a revised order to the Court to incorporate these timelines into a new briefing schedule.

² The parties are attempting to meet and confer to ascertain the status of the case and whether a substitution of counsel will be filed. The parties will then arrange a conference call with the court to discuss the status of the case.

- 2. The current scheduling order is out of date and an updated proposed revised Scheduling Order (Fifth Amended) will be submitted to the Court.
