THIS MATTER having been reassigned to the Bergen County Vicinage, from Atlantic County, pursuant to the Supreme Court's Order of October 31, 2014; the Court having conducted a Case Management Conference on July 22, 2022; counsel appearing; for good cause shown and for the reasons set forth on the record;

I. CASE MANAGEMENT

A. Trial Settings.

1. <u>Trial Setting (Prolift)</u>: This trial remains set for May 1, 2023. (The Court denied Defendants' request to adjourn the trial to June 20, 2023). The parties will meet and confer to submit a pretrial scheduling order that contemplates opening statements on May 1, 2023, and in-court jury selection beginning on April 24, 2023. - 2. <u>Trial Setting (TVT retropubic)</u>: The June 20, 2023 trial setting for the TVT pool shall be adjourned to a date in the fall of 2023, pending input from the MCL judge.
- 3. Additional trial settings: The parties will meet and confer regarding the CMO 74 and CMO 84 cases that are undergoing case work up to evaluate case candidates and proposals for future additional trial settings with input from the MCL judge.
