**CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER #48**


All Prior orders remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Order.

THIS MATTER having been reassigned to the Bergen County Vicinage, from Atlantic County, pursuant to the Supreme Court's Order of October 31, 2014; for good cause shown;

IT IS on this <sup>th</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2018, **ORDERED** that the Court's Order dated May 1, 2018, and Case Management Order Nos. 44, 45, 46, and 47 are hereby amended as follows:

- I. TVT-O February 18, 2019 trial setting. It having been brought to the attention of the Court that the case of Gomez, Blanca Estella Hipolito (BER-L-009761-15), Bernstein Liebhard, Law Offices of Jan Meyer & Associates, also involves another implanted product in addition to the TVT-O product and thus is not qualified to remain a candidate for the February trial setting.
