

- (iii) By August 5, 2024, Defendants are to serve the curriculum vitae of their pathology expert(s);

- (iv) Defense pathology expert report(s) shall be served by September 16, 2024.
- (v) Defense pathology expert(s) deposition(s) will not be conducted until after completion of plaintiffs' pathology expert(s) deposition(s).
- (vi) Expert discovery shall be completed by November 4, 2024.

B. No other deadlines established by CMO 84 shall-be extended absent further order of the Court.
