**THIS MATTER**, having been brought before the Court by Plaintiff Pamela Ronee Flynn, through her counsel, and Defendants Ethicon, Inc., on its own behalf and on behalf of its division, Ethicon Women's Health and Urology (also incorrectly named as "Gynecare"), and Johnson & Johnson, through their counsel Riker, Danzig, Scherer, Hyland & Perretti, LLP, and the parties now jointly seeking an Order dismissing all claims cross-claims, and third-party claims between the parties, and for good cause shown;

**IT IS** on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2022;

**ORDERED** that all of plaintiff's claims related to the TVT medical device implanted in 2003 (including any and all treatment related to such TVT device) are hereby dismissed **WITH prejudice**;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this matter and all claims, cross-claims, and third-party claims asserted between and among the parties related to the TVT-Abbrevo device implanted in 2012 be and are hereby dismissed **WITHOUT** prejudice. The parties shall bear their own fees and costs.
