IT IS on this 30<sup>th</sup> day of AUGUST, 2023,


**ORDERED** as follows:

(2) For purposes of clarification, prospectively the total amount of common benefit assessments disclosed each quarter in the reports to the Court (not identifying the law firms or settlement amounts), and the amount of the deposit(s) made into the Mazie Slater Katz & Freeman LLC Trust Account, will be provided to Adam M. Slater, Common Benefit Liaison Counsel.

It is **FURTHER ORDERED** that Defendants' Motion for Clarification of May 25, 2023, Order and Opinion on Common Benefit Allocation ("May 25, 2023, Order") and Case Management Order #71 ("CMO #71) be withdrawn in favor of this Order, and
