**ORDER ADMITTING

PRO HAC VICE**

**THIS MATTER** having been opened to the Court by Faegre Drinker Biddle & Reath LLP, attorneys for defendants Mentor Worldwide LLC, Ethicon, Inc., and Johnson & Johnson, to permit Zach Adams, Esq., an attorney admitted to the practice of law in the State of Ohio, to participate with other counsel for defendants in all phases of the trial, and it appearing that Zach Adams, Esq. is a licensed attorney in good standing in the State of Ohio, and it appearing that Plaintiff's Complaint raises products liability claims, and it further appearing that the law practice of Zach Adams, Esq. focuses on the trial and appeal of products liability cases, and it further appearing that defendants has requested that Zach Adams, Esq. represent it in this matter, and the Court having considered the respective Certifications of Jessica L. Brennan, Esq. and Zach Adams, Esq. submitted in support of the Motion, and for good cause having been shown:

IT IS on this 29<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2022, ORDERED that Zach Adams, Esq. shall and hereby is admitted *pro hac vice* and is authorized to appear and participate with other counsel for defendants in all phases of the trial, subject to the following conditions:

1. Zach Adams, Esq. shall abide by the New Jersey Court Rules including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2.

2. Zach Adams, Esq. shall, and hereby does, consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as his agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against his that may arise out of his participation in this matter.

3. Zach Adams, Esq. shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.

4. Zach Adams, Esq. shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein.

5. Zach Adams, Esq. cannot be designated as trial counsel and must be accompanied by a member of the New Jersey Bar at all proceedings, unless specifically waived by the Court.

6. No discovery, motion, trial, or any other proceeding delay shall occur or be requested by reason of the inability of Zach Adams, Esq. to be in attendance.

7. Zach Adams, Esq. must, within ten (10) days, pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2 and submit an affidavit of compliance.

8. The *pro hac vice* admission of Zach Adams, Esq. will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payment required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2.

9. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this Order shall constitute grounds for removal.

10. A true copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel of record within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
