THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by Faegre Drinker Biddle & Reath LLP, attorneys for defendant Mentor Worldwide LLC, to permit Seth J. Linnick, Esq., an attorney admitted to the practice of law in the state of Ohio, to participate with other counsel for defendant in all phases of the trial, and it appearing that Seth J. Linnick, Esq. is a licensed attorney in good standing in the state of Ohio, and it appearing that Plaintiffs' Complaint raises products liability claims, and it further appearing that the law practice of Seth J. Linnick, Esq. focuses on the trial and appeal of products liability cases, and it further appearing that defendant has requested that Seth J. Linnick, Esq. represent it in this matter, and the Court having considered the respective Certifications of Jessica L. Brennan, Esq. and Seth J. Linnick, Esq. submitted in support of the Motion, and for good cause having been shown:

IT IS on this 6th day of October, 2021, ORDERED that Seth J. Linnick shall and hereby is admitted *pro hac vice* and is authorized to appear and participate with other counsel for defendant in all phases of the trial, subject to the following conditions:

1. Seth J. Linnick, Esq. shall abide by the New Jersey Court Rules including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2.

2. Seth J. Linnick, Esq. shall, and hereby does, consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as his agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against him that may arise out of his participation in this matter.

3. Seth J. Linnick, Esq. shall immediately notify the Court of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other jurisdiction.

4. Seth J. Linnick, Esq. shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for them, the conduct of the litigation and the attorney admitted herein.

5. Seth J. Linnick, Esq. cannot be designated as trial counsel and must be accompanied by a member of the New Jersey Bar at all proceedings, unless specifically waived by the Court.


6. No discovery, motion, trial or any other proceeding delay shall occur or be requested by reason of the inability of Seth J. Linnick, Esq. to be in attendance.

7. Seth J. Linnick, Esq. must, within ten (10) days, pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2 and submit an affidavit of compliance.

8. The *pro hac vice* admission of Seth J. Linnick, Esq. will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payment required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2.

9. Non-compliance with any of the terms of this Order shall constitute grounds for removal.

10. A true copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel of record within seven (7) days of the date hereof.
