**PROPOSED ORDER FOR ADMITTING CHRISTOPHER LOPALO PRO HAC VICE**

AND NOW, Napoli Shkolnik PLLC, counsel for Plaintiffs upon notice to all interested parties, has moved before this Court for admission *pro hac vice* of Christopher LoPalo, Esquire, the Court having considered the papers in support thereof; and the Court having found that Christopher LoPalo is a member in good standing for the bar of the highest Court in the State where Christopher LoPalo resides and principally practices law and further good cause shown.

IT IS ON THIS 13<sup>TH</sup> day of July, 2023.

3. Notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing before this Court; and;

4. Have all pleadings and other papers filed in the court signed by an attorney at law of this Court employed by Napoli Shkolnik PLLC who shall be responsible for the conduct of Christopher LoPalo; and it is further ORDERED that Christopher LoPalo shall make payment of all fees due to the State of New Jersey within 30 days of the entry of the *pro hac vice* Order allowing for admission and as provided in the New Jersey Rules of Court, Rule 1:20-2, and 1:28B-1 (e); and is further ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Treasurer of the New Jersey Fund for Client Protection; and its further

ORDERED that copies of this Order shall be served by attorneys for Plaintiffs upon all counsel of record within seven (7) days of the receipt thereof.
