- 5. Sarah Bunce, Esq. cannot be designated as trial counsel and must be accompanied by a member of the New Jersey Bar at all proceedings, unless specifically waived by the Court.
- 6. No discovery, motion, trial, or any other proceeding delay shall occur or be requested by reason of the inability of Sarah Bunce, Esq. to be in attendance.
- 7. Sarah Bunce, Esq. must, within ten (10) days, pay the fees required by <u>R.</u> 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2 and submit an affidavit of compliance.
- 8. The *pro hac vice* admission of Sarah Bunce, Esq. will automatically terminate for failure to make the initial and any annual payment required by R. 1:20-1(b) and R. 1:28-2.

- Non-compliance with any of the terms of this Order shall constitute grounds for 9. removal.
- A true copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel of record within seven 10. (7) days of the date hereof.
