ORDER
FOR ADMISSION TO PRACTICE
PRO HAC VICE

WHEREAS, Plaintiffs, by and through their attorneys Sadaka Associates, LLC, upon notice to all interested parties, has moved before this Court for admission *pro hac vice* of TIMOTHY E. JACKSON, ESQ., the Court having considered the papers submitted in support thereof; and the Court having found that TIMOTHY E. JACKSON, ESQ. is a member of good standing before the bar of the highest court of the state where he is domiciled and principally practices law and for other good cause shown.

IT IS on this 30 day of November, 2023, hereby

ORDERED that this motion is granted, and TIMOTHY E. JACKSON, ESQ. is admitted *pro hac vice* before this Court, pursuant to R.1:21-2, for all purposes and in all proceedings in the


same manner as an attorney who is admitted to practice in this State and is domiciled and maintains an office for practice of law in the State of New Jersey, provided that:

1. TIMOTHY E. JACKSON, ESQ. shall abide by the *New Jersey Court Rules* including all disciplinary rules, R. 1:20-1 and R. 1:28-2;
2. TIMOTHY E. JACKSON, ESQ. shall, and hereby does, consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as his agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against Mark T. Sadaka that may arise out of his participation in this case;
3. TIMOTHY E. JACKSON, ESQ. shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any court; and
4. TIMOTHY E. JACKSON, ESQ. shall have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice law in the State of New Jersey, who shall be held responsible for the case and for the conduct of Mark T. Sadaka therein.

ORDERED that TIMOTHY E. JACKSON, ESQ. must, within thirty (30) days, submit a copy of this Order and pay the fees required by R. 1:20-1(b), R. 1:28-2 and 1:28B-1(e), and it is further

ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be served on all parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof.

A copy of this order shall be served upon all counsel of record by eCourts. Movant shall serve all parties not served electronically within 7 days hereof.
