

**RIDER TO ORDER**

Before this Court is Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to Amend Certain Complaints pursuant to R. 4:9-1. The Injured Plaintiffs seek leave to amend their complaints to add personal injury claims arising from the same conduct alleged in their prior complaints. The New Plaintiffs seek leave to be added as party-plaintiffs to existing complaints. Defendant DuPont "opposes" this application, arguing that it is barred by the Armona settlement.
