THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court by application of H. 1. The motion to admit Gina M. Saelinger of the law firm of Ulmer & Berne LLP is granted in all respects, and Gina M. Saelinger is admitted *pro hac vice* to speak and serve in the matter in the same manner as attorneys authorized to practice before this Court would be.

2. Gina M. Saelinger shall abide by the New Jersey Court Rules including all disciplinary rules.


3. Gina M. Saelinger shall consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the New Jersey Supreme Court as an agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against her or her firm arising out of her participation in these matters.

4. Gina M. Saelinger shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting her standing with the Bar of any other Court.

5. Gina M. Saelinger shall allow all pleadings, briefs, and other papers filed with the Court to be signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this State, who shall be held responsible for them, and for the conduct of the cause and for her conduct herein.

6. Gina M. Saelinger shall, within fifteen (15) days, ensure that any and all fees required by the New Jersey Supreme Court pursuant to Rule 1:20-1(b) and the New Jersey Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection pursuant to Rule 1:28-2 have been paid.

7. A copy of this Order shall be served on all counsel within ten (10) days of the date hereof.
