ORDER GRANTING *PRO HAC VICE* ADMISSION OF CRAIG A. THOMPSON

ORDERED that Craig A. Thompson shall notify the Court immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the Bar of any other Court; and it is further

ORDERED that all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Court shall be signed by Beth S. Rose, Vincent Lodato or another member or associate of the firm of Sills Cummis & Gross P.C. who is a member in good standing of the Bar of this Court, who shall be held responsible for said papers and for the conduct of the case and who shall be present before the Court as well as responsible for the conduct of the attorney admitted *pro hac vice* pursuant to the terms of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that Craig A. Thompson shall pay the annual fees to the New Jersey Lawyers Fund for Client Protection and the New Jersey Lawyers Assistance Programs in accordance with Rule 1:28-2 and Rule 1:28B-1 within 15 days from the date of the entry of this Order.
